3. **Continuing Professional Development for Principals**

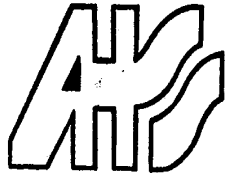
The Association has submitted a response to the Consultation Paper on Continuing Professional Development for Principals in early April. Members can view the paper on the Association's homepage.

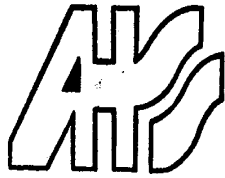
