2. Study Trip to Taichung

13 of our Executive Committee, Co-opted and Task Force members participated in the "Study Trip to Tai Chung: Adaptive Learning @ SRL" in April 2017. During the 4-day trip in Tai Chung, we visited secondary and primary schools of different backgrounds, listened to talks arranged by Professor Bor-chen Kuo (郭伯臣教授) of National Taichung

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University of Education. All these helped us understand more about the education system and education reform in Taiwan. We also tried to explore the possibility and directions of the future development of Self-regulated Learning and Adaptive Learning. It was indeed a fruitful trip.

3. Happy Hour Forum

Our Happy Hour Forum, themed "From Adaptive Learning to Learning to Learn 2.0: Reflections and Inspiration from Tai Chung Study Trip", held on 9 May 2017 was well received.
